## **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCEDURES FOR AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN: CITY OF REEDSBURG**

### **Purpose**

The City of Reedsburg City Council previously adopted a City comprehensive plan under Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes, which is documented in a report titled “Comprehensive Plan of the City of Reedsburg 2012 Update.” The comprehensive plan was prepared in accordance with a public participation plan adopted by the City Council at that time that included activities to foster public participation in the preparation of the comprehensive plan. Under Section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes, future amendments or new comprehensive plans must also be carried out in accordance with a public participation plan, adopted by the City Council, designed to foster public participation. Public participation helps to ensure that the resulting comprehensive plan accurately reflects the vision, goals, and values of citizens in the community.

The balance of this document describes the process to be followed by the City to foster public participation in the consideration of the comprehensive plan. While no specific dates are outlined in this plan, the document serves as a general guideline for the methods of public outreach, the mechanisms, and the meetings to be held.

### **Goals**

The City of Reedsburg, Wisconsin and staff will work to:

- Ensure that a broad range of interests are considered in the comprehensive planning process;
- Actively seek involvement from the general public;
- Ensure that the planning process is inclusive as possible and the perspectives of all the interested parties influence the plan;
- Serve as liaisons to, and perform outreach to, individuals and groups throughout the community;
- Truly engage the entire community and stakeholder interest groups so that the plan becomes a “living plan” with community buy-in and transparency.

### **Public Participation Activities and Procedures for the Comprehensive Plan**

The City will, at minimum, use the following techniques to obtain public input during the plan update process:

#### **1. Background Materials**

The City will provide opportunities for public review of materials describing the comprehensive plan (text, maps, tables), including the following:

- Electronic copies of various draft materials throughout the planning process will be made available on the City website with links to a specific comprehensive plan update website known as [www.ReedsburgCompPlan.com](http://www.ReedsburgCompPlan.com).
- Printed copies of final draft materials will be made available at the City Hall.
- Meeting minutes and agendas will be made available on the City’s website as they take place.

#### **2. Public Participation Methods**

It is intended that the following public participation methods will be made available throughout the analysis portions of the comprehensive plan update:

- Steering Committee: The Steering Committee (The Plan Commission) will hold various meetings throughout the planning process to engage on analyses and approvals of sections of the plan.

The meetings will be made available to the public allowing written or verbal comments. The Steering Committee may engage in providing topic specific related public open house meetings.

- Stakeholder Interviews: Consultants will work with City Staff to identify individuals, organizations, and businesses to gather input about past and future land use and development decisions.
- Online Engagement: The City has employed an online software called Mindmixer as part of the comprehensive plan update process. A dedicated online engagement website (<https://reedsburgcompplan.mindmixer.com>) will be used to engage citizens and interested parties on all smart growth planning elements including the use of topic questions, surveys, mapping, and pictures. All data received from the online engagement website will be incorporated into future goals and recommendations in the new plan.
- Website & Social Media: The City website will have links to a dedicated comprehensive plan website ([www.ReedsburgCompPlan.com](http://www.ReedsburgCompPlan.com)) allowing “general comment” links for all interested parties. City social media may also become an option for public input during the process as well.
- Public Workshop: A public meeting workshop will take place to review goals, objectives, trends, and survey results in order to gather input to direct changes to the smart growth elements.
- Open House: A public open house meeting will occur to allow all interested parties to review proposed plan recommendations.
- Adoption Meetings: As provided in Section 3 below a variety of public input opportunities will take place during the final adoption process of the plan including a public hearing and Plan Commission/City Council meetings.

### **3. Adoption Procedures**

#### **Public Hearing**

As required by Section 66.1001(4)(d), the City will hold a public hearing on the comprehensive plan. The hearing may be held by the Plan Commission, City Council, or jointly by the Plan Commission and City Council. The hearing will include a background presentation of the new plan describing the proposed plan followed by an opportunity for the public to comment on the proposed plan. The City Plan Commission and City Council will consider public testimony provided at the hearing and any written comments submitted to the City prior to the hearing during their deliberations on the proposed plan.

#### **Notice of Public Hearing**

The public hearing will be preceded by a Class 1 notice that is published or posted at least 30 days before the hearing is held. In accordance with Section 66.1001(4)(d), the notice will include the date, time, and place of the hearing; a brief summary of the proposed comprehensive plan and/or a map illustrating the proposed plan; a local staff contact who may be contacted for additional information on the proposed plan and to whom written comments regarding the plan may be submitted; and information regarding where and when the proposed plan may be inspected before the hearing and how a copy of the proposed plan may be obtained.

#### **Notification to Interested Parties**

The City Clerk will provide a copy of the public hearing notice and the proposed plan at least 30 days prior to the public hearing to any person who submits a written request to receive notice of a proposed plan under Section 66.1001(4)(f). The City may charge a fee to cover the cost of providing such notice.

#### **Plan Commission Recommendation**

Following the public hearing, the Plan Commission will make a recommendation to the City Council to approve, deny, or modify the proposed plan. The Plan Commission's recommendation will be in the form of a resolution approved by a majority of the full membership of the Plan Commission.

**City Council Action**

Following Plan Commission action, the City Council will consider the plan and the Plan Commission's recommendation and approve, deny, or refer the proposed plan back to the Plan Commission. If approved, City Council approval will be in the form of an ordinance adopted by a majority of the full membership of the City Council.

**Distribution of Plan**

If approved by the City Council, printed or electronic copies of the plan will be sent by the City Clerk to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b).



Q2 Do you currently live in the City of Reedsburg?





## Q4 If living in the City, how long?







## Q31 Is there sufficient parking in downtown Reedsburg?


